Rock Island County Health Department VACCINE INFORMATION



Rock Island County Health Department closing National Guard vaccination site on May 29

The Camden Centre COVID-19 mass vaccination site will close at 4 p.m. Saturday, May 29, but the health department will offer vaccinations at its Rock Island clinic twice a week starting the week of June 1.

Many vaccination opportunities remain throughout the Quad Cities and your local pharmacy.

The health department will offer a walk-in vaccine clinic located at 2112 25th Ave., Rock Island on Tuesday and Friday:

Tuesdays: 9 a.m. to noon and 1-4 p.m., starting June 1 for Moderna and Johnson & Johnson

Fridays, 9 a.m. to noon and 1-4 p.m., starting June 4 for Pfizer

STOP- Where are your Children?

Please remind your children they should not be playing or riding their bikes in parking lots that have a great deal of traffic. There have been several complaints of children riding their bikes or running between cars and almost getting hit. Some of the children are very young and hard to see around and over vehicles.

One Factor in lease agreement under Lease Termination by Landlord states:

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

DO NOT PARK IN THE FIRELANES- A fire lane is for easy access to hydrants in case of a fire. Fire lane curbs are painted in yellow. If your vehicle is parked in a fire lane, your vehicle will be subject to immediate towing.

SYRINGES NEED TO BE DISPOSED OF PROPERLY- Syringes used for medical purposes need to be placed in a plastic container, ie. laundry detergent container, and sealed prior to disposing.

HIGHRISES- Know who you are letting in the building. Do not buzz individuals in the building that you are not familiar with.

SLOW DOWN AND BE ALERT - When driving through the complex and parking lots, watch for children and adults out enjoying the warm weather.
