DO NOT remove the batteries or the detectors from the ceiling or walls. It is a "Lease Violation" to tamper with these items. If there is beeping from the Smoke or CO detector you MUST contact the office immediately for maintenance to come out and assess and resolve the situation.

PROPERTY MANAGER NEWS
