Rent is due to be paid by the 7th of every month, if a copy of the rent calendar is needed, please contact your property manager.

Changes to Income and Household <u>must be reported</u> to the appropriate staff member within 10 Days.

Failure to properly report changes will result in repayment due.

Animals <u>must be leashed</u> and accompanied by an adult at all times while outside of their residence.

**Smoking of any kind is <u>prohibited</u>** while inside of units, you <u>must</u> use applicable designated areas. STREED TOWER

Pets are not permitted to hang out in common areas including lobbies, community room, and laundry areas.

#### Winter Weather is Here Tips to Stay Safe

Keep your thermostats at 62° F or above and open areas which may not get heat to them as needed; cabinets, interior doors, etc.

Inclement weather can happen at any time, make sure your household has what it needs in case weather disrupts travel.

When traveling by vehicle, make sure you have a safety bag which holds blankets, salt/sand, flares, spare tire, jumper cables, flashlight, small shovel, ice scraper, additional clothing, water, and nonperishable food items.

Make sure your furnace and water heater areas are clear so maintenance can get to these items for repair as needed.
