Riverbend Produce Drop: Join us on December 18, 2024, from 1 PM to 3 PM. Sign up by December 11, 2024.

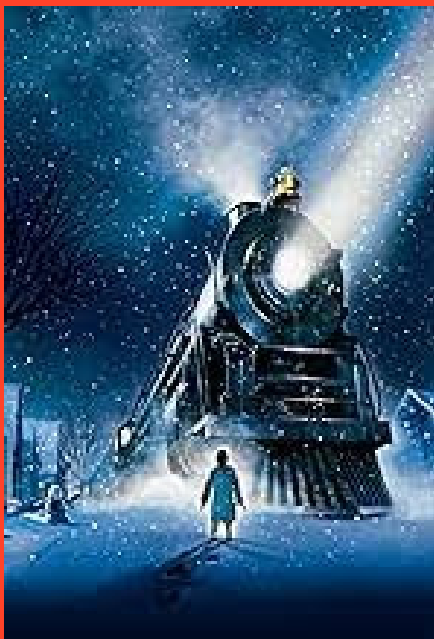
Winter/Snow Season: Salt is available at the office (bring your own container). You are responsible for shoveling your sidewalks and porches, while maintenance will handle common areas.

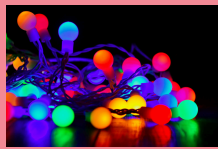
