-Cat Owners - Please put used cat litter in a plastic bag **BEFORE** tossing into the garbage shoot.

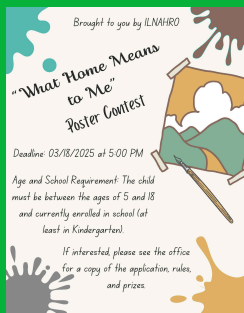

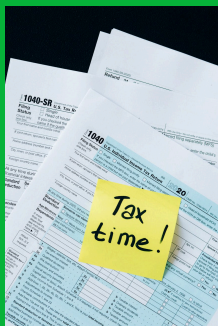
