Take all trash directly to the dumpster, Do not leave outside!



**COLCANNON-** In honor of St. Patrick's Day, cook up a pot of colcannon. All you need is potatoes, cabbage, butter, green onions, chicken broth and milk. Cook your potatoes - (red with skins on are preferred), while they are cooking, skillet cook your cabbage and chop your green onions. Once the potatoes are done, mash with milk, chicken broth and a bit of butter. Mix in the other ingredients . Perfectly fine on it's own but always good a little corned beef and a piece of hot crusty bread.
